


## **AMAZE Videos Tipsheet**


Providers are now able to assign AMAZE videos for patients to view in MyChart.

## **Provider Workflow**

1. From the "more" button, access the drop-down menu in the patient's chart, and select "Education."




2. Open the "Education" activity






3. Type "AMAZE" in the search bar.




- 4. Identify and select the videos that need to be assigned to the patient. Select the video by clicking the check box.
- 5. Click "Accept."






- 6. The selected videos will be added to the left side of the screen, showing that they have been associated with the patient.
- 7. To add additional details about the video, select the video check boxes and click on "Document."



- 8. A window will pop up to document information around the discussion regarding the AMAZE videos:
  - a. Who the learners are
  - b. Their readiness to learn
  - c. The method they are receiving the information
  - d. The response from the learner








## **Patient Instructions**

4. Select the "Open education" button.






5. Select the video.




6. Click "Watch The Video Here" link.
