







It's important you talk to someone you trust, like your mom, a teacher or the school counselor.




Talking to us is a good start. You're not alone!






In emergency situations, if someone harms you, it's up to adults to believe you, keep you safe, and help you.

DID YOU KNOW...

Some actions to prevent sexual violence in school:

All people who work in an educational institution must treat their students with respect. To achieve this, keep in mind that no one should:

1. Request a meeting with you alone outside of school, or in isolated places.
 2. Ask you to exchange intimate photos or videos, send you messages, or any type of content that makes you uncomfortable.
 3. Use double meanings or suggestive messages that make you feel harassed or uncomfortable.
 4. Touch any part of your body, especially your private parts, without your permission.
 5. No adult may have any type of romantic or sexual relationship with children or teens.
