

First, check the expiration date on the condom package to make sure the condom isn't expired.



Then, open the condom package. Never use your teeth, scissors or any sharp object, you may rip or cut the condom.



Before sex, take out the condom...




The condom should roll easily. If not, it might be inside-out. In that case, throw it away and use a new one.



Hold the tip of the condom to remove any air and then roll the condom down to the base of the erect penis.




After ejaculation, withdraw the penis while it is still erect.



Hold onto the base of the penis to keep the condom from falling off.

Remove the condom, tie a knot at the end to keep the semen inside, wrap it in a tissue, and throw it in the trash.





Remember, use a new condom every time you have sex.




Condoms come in different shapes and sizes. There are also different colors and textures. It is important to find a condom that is comfortable for you and your partner.

Some condoms have lubricant to make them more comfortable during sex.



But not all of them do...



If you're using a non-lubricated condom, it's best to go with a water-based lubricant.

Never use Vaseline or other oil-based lubricants, as they will break down the condom.



Condoms can be purchased at many stores, including pharmacies, drug stores, and grocery stores and even in some gas stations.
